Weekly Discussion Question: Your weekly discussion questions are located in the Discussion Board section of your virtual classroom. Your discussion response must be 100 words or more and must contain 5 terms/concepts from your weekly lecture and reading. Your discussion responses are formal responses (no slang, emoticons, or typos) which demonstrate your understanding of the concepts covered during the week and allow us an opportunity to apply those concepts in the real world so that they are more meaningful. You are also required to respond to at least two of your classmate's discussion posts. These responses should be meaningful; something more than “hey, I agree with you...” They should also be more than a couple of sentences long.

The goal of the discussion board is to engage in meaningful dialogue. Just “tossing” 5 or 10 terms into your response isn’t what I’m looking for. Make every effort to use your terms and concepts correctly. Please **bold or highlight** the terms/concepts when you use them. Let your text and lectures guide you in your discussion of images. Your discussion should be deconstruction and analysis, not simply opinion. It is important to also include your visceral reaction to an image should you experience one. As you discuss your own images tell us what you expect/hope your viewer’s reaction to be.
