LAB POLICIES & PROCEDURES POLICIES

- All missed labs must be made up as described with necessary equipment.
- Three or more labs missed without makeups will result in an automatic failing grade for the lab and therefore the class.
- Labs should be completed during the lab section, but depending on the lab, up until the following week may be given to complete the lab.
- **No late labs will be accepted.**
- **Absence does not excuse a lab deadline except in extenuating circumstances. Being sick would be one of those extenuating circumstances.**
- You must have access to a removeable storage device (USB thumb drive, hard drive, Dropbox, etc.).
- Back up all your work. Computers crash and papers/pictures/videos/files go missing, be responsible.
